

New Probation/Eligibility from 6/7/23 Meeting

A new probation/ ineligible process was created by the HS leadership team, HS coaches, Activities Director, and HS administration.

- New probation/eligibility list will be run [roughly] every 4 weeks (every *mid-quarter* and *quarter*).
- A student that has one or more F's at the end of each 4-week period will be placed on the probation list and will be eligible for participation.
 - Any student who participates in extracurricular activities will be **REQUIRED** to attend tutoring for the next four weeks until the next grade report is run. Even if a student raises their "F" in the first week, they **MUST** still attend tutoring the remaining 3 weeks of the cycle.
 - 1 F = 1 day of tutoring a week; 2 F's = 2 days of tutoring a week
 - Tutoring will be held before and after school (6:30-7:30am and 3:30-4:30pm).
 - This allows a student at least 8 tutoring options during the week.
 - Coaches will encourage students on probation to attend morning tutoring sessions so they are able to attend practices after school.
 - If the student raises their failing grades while on probation and do not have any F's when the next grading cycle is run, they will be taken off of the probation list and will not have to attend tutoring the next 4 weeks.
 - However, if a student does **NOT** raise their failing grades during their time on the probation list the following will occur:
 - Student still has 1 F = will have to attend tutoring an additional 4 weeks.
 - Student still has 2 F's = will be **INELIGIBLE** to participate in their extracurricular activity until that grade is raised to passing (minimum of 1 week on ineligible list).
 - MSHSAA eligibility requirements will be followed if a student is not passing 6 classes or has 2 or more F's at Semester.

Probation/Eligibility Process
