

RESIDENCY AFFIDAVIT

The signatures of _____ and _____ affixed to this affidavit confirm that _____ are presently living with the _____ family full-time at _____.

Should the living arrangements change it is the duty of both sets of families to alert the school.

Section 167.020 of the Revised Statutes of Missouri states that a child must be domiciled and physically residing in the school district of which the child attends and that “**any person who knowingly submits false information to satisfy any requirement of subsection 2 of this section is guilty of a class A misdemeanor**”. The domicile of a minor child shall be the domicile of a parent, military guardian pursuant to a military-issued guardianship or court-appointed legal guardian. In addition, **the statute enables school districts to seek tuition reimbursement from the family for the time the student was attending the school as a non-resident.** *Tuition is approximately \$6,500/year per child.*

It is the practice of the Seneca School District to seek damages (tuition) for any child whose parents knowingly falsified documentation to keep the student in the district.
