In order to be eligible to access school virtually through Seneca R-7 the following requirements are in place:

1. Students wishing to enroll in virtual learning must be enrolled as a full-time student in the Seneca R-7 School District. The student will be enrolled as a full-time virtual student/
2. The student must have been enrolled in school as a full-time student in a public school during the semester immediately prior to enrolling unless the student had a documented medical or psychological diagnosis that prevent the student from attending school in the community during the previous semester.
3. Students in seated or virtual coursework will develop an Individual Career and Academic Plan in conjunction with the student's school.
4. Courses taken virtually will be taken at home.
5. The district will supply a Chromebook for Seneca R-7 for students to access virtual courses from home at the request of the student/parent.
6. Students must submit their own work. The policy on plagiarism follows:

a. First Plagiarism offense—student receives notification the work on an assignment is plagiarized. The assignment will be reset (if using Edgenuity). A parent will be notified by the teacher. Proper documentation will be completed by teacher and or principal.

b. Second Plagiarism offense—student receives notification the work on an assignment is plagiarized, and a principal will be contacted as well as the parent. The student will earn a zero on the assignment. Warning will be given that if such plagiarism happens a third time, the student will lose credit in the class. Proper documentation will be completed by teacher and or principal.

c. Third Plagiarism offense—student and parent will receive notification, and lose credit in the class.

7. Students who fail a course or who do not meet the attendance/progress requirements of the virtual provider may be removed from the virtual program.

8. Students may enroll and withdraw from courses in accordance with district policy. High school students who withdraw from a virtual course after the 10th day of the semester will receive an F for the course just as they would in a traditional seated course.
